

Did the Internal Revenue Service Extend Tax Return Filing Deadlines and Defer Due Dates for 2019 Tax Payments Due to COVID-19?

Updated as of March 21, 2020:

- As described in IRS [Notice 2020-18](#), the due date to file U.S. federal income tax returns and pay associated 2019 income taxes generally has been extended to July 15, 2020.
